FAQs of the Month

I am enrolled in one winter course at VT, but no longer want to take it. How do I drop the course?

• Students are not able to drop their final credits for a term through Hokie Spa. To drop all of your enrolled winter credits, use the Resignation/Withdrawal form.

How do I add a minor?

- **COE minors:** Add using the <u>COE online form</u> during a Change or Major/Minor period. The current period is open through Jan. 3, 2025.
- **College of Science (COS) minors:** Use the "Change of Second Major/Minor/Option" form found on the <u>COS</u> <u>forms website</u>. This can be done at any time.
- Pamplin College of Business minors: Use the online application and follow the instructions found here.
- **Minors in other VT colleges:** Contact the department/college offering the minor for assistance. Find a list of VT minors and contact information for them here.

How do I apply for College of Engineering Scholarships?

- As a continuing COE student, there are a few steps involved in applying for VT/COE/AOE scholarships. Lots of information about the process can be found on the COE scholarships website.
- To be eligible for financial need-based scholarships (the majority of scholarships) you must complete the FAFSA. Information about filling out the FAFSA from the Office of University Scholarships & Financial Aid can be found here.
- You need to complete the VT General Scholarship Application in <u>Scholarship Central</u>. Deadline to be considered for University-level scholarships is Jan. 22, 2025.
- Once you have completed the general application, you need to complete the College of Engineering Scholarship Application in <u>Scholarship Central</u> by March 1, 2025. This will put you into consideration for COE/AOE-level scholarships.

Are there any other scholarships I can apply for?
